Second, request that the BCC reaffirm or readdress this Board's role with respect to authority over Clam Bay maintenance and operations, and Canoe Trail markers. Third, evaluate separately and reaffirm the authority of this Board, more as an administrative body as opposed to an advisory body. Fourth, resolve conflicts in any ordinance that transfers this Board's jurisdiction to another entity. After this Board approves this resolution, it should be placed on an upcoming January, 2011 Board of County Commissioners' regular agenda.
